Dear Superintendent Talison and Board President Mays,

On June 10, 2016, the State Treasurer, pursuant to Section 1220(5) of 2015 PA 111 (MCL §380.1220(5)), determined that the Beecher Community School District (BCSD) was statutorily mandated to submit for approval and enhanced deficit elimination plan (EDEP). On October 3, 2016, the Department of Treasury approved the district's EDEP submitted on September 19, 2016.

This letter serves as approval of the district's EDEP submitted June 8, 2017. This letter of approval recognizes that the district shall do the following:

- Reduce the deficit by at least the targeted amount of \$335,839.
- Close the Coates and Tucker buildings.
- Perform a year-end pupil count prior to June 30 to validate final enrollment and establish a baseline for measuring marketing activities through the October 2017 Fall count day.
- Provide an updated enrollment and attendance percent report every two weeks through Friday, September 29, 2017.
- Continue to review district operations to identify additional cost savings from FY 2017-18 through FY 2019-20; and incorporate any additional costs that are needed to implement the district's strategic plan.
